

Jolly Boys visit to Bristol - 14th October 2004

Arrangements the same as previous visit in 2000 but with a couple of different pubs.

Temple Meads Station - 1 min walk to Bus Stop for either Service No. 8 or 9. They run alternately every six minutes. Ask for City Centre. Journey time to Centre 10 minutes.

City Centre - cross over to the opposite side of City Centre - The White Lion is between Small Street and St Stephen's Street. (Early birds could go to No. 3 first (2 mins from No.1) opens at 10. o'clock for food and alcoholic refreshment)

4a Cornubia, Temple Street - 3 mins from 4 (10 from 3) Smiles Ales + guests + food	14.03 to 14.45
4b (Alternative if required for 4) Kings Head, Victoria Street - 2 mins from 4a GBG 2004 - Small one bar - Sharps Doom Bar, Bass & Courage)	
5 Knights Templar, Temple Quay - 5 mins from 4a Another "newer" Wetherspoons in redeveloped area.	14.50 to finish?

From 5 it is approximately three minutes back to Temple Meads Station entrance via a pedestrian walkway.
