- Seven Stars, 6-8, Dantzic Street, M4 2BS. Wetherspoons. Only recommended for breakfast. Only had Greene King and variants available when we went. W on map.
- 2. Crown and Kettle, 2, Oldham Rd., M4 5FE junction with Great Ancoats St. Tram Shudehill. 0161 236 2923. www.crownandkettle.com. 1100 opening. Beer range varies usually 4. Food. The pub reopened by Artisan Regeneration in 2005, after being closed for 16 years. Free house it consists of a vault room, main room and modern snug. Note the ornate ceiling in this listed building. Cross the junction on to Oldham St. in the direction of the city centre. A minutes walk on the left hand side. No. 4 on map. Go up Shude Hill turn right into Swan Street.
- 3. Bar Fringe, 8, Swan St. M4 5JN near Oldham Rd. Tram Shudehill. 0160 835 3815. 1200 opening (although staff said it opens at 1100). Bank Top, Boggart, guest beers. Wide selection of Belgian and German beers. A very short walk away, crossing the junction. No. 3 on map.
- 4. The Smithfield, 37, Swan St. M4 5JZ junction with Coop St. Tram Shudehill. 0161 839 4424. 1200 opening. Phoenix Smithfield Bitter, Robinsons Hatters Dark, Guest beers (6). A short walk along Swan St. Lease was up for sale when we went so hopefully it will be open. Good pub. No. 2 on map.
- 5. Marble Arch, 73, Rochdale Road M4 4HY junction with Gould Street. Tram Shudehill. 0161 832 5914. www.marblebeers.com. 1130 opening. Home of the Marble Brewery. This corner pub has a wealth of ornate tiling, a barrel vaulted ceiling, and associated frieze which complement the mosaic sloping floor down to the bar. No. 1 on map
