Jolly Boys' Visit to Exeter Thursday 18th February 2010.

Culture: -

Loads, and on this occasion we will be passing near Exeter College and the Prison, also the statue of Sir General Redvers Buller who, with three generations before him, served as Member of Parliament for Exeter. Buller had a distinguished army career serving all over the 'British Empire' and in South Africa during the Zulu Wars he was awarded the Victoria Cross for rescuing three comrades from certain death. After serving in the Sudan he commanded the British forces in South Africa against the Boers. He lead several failed attempts to relieve the siege of Ladysmith and although his forces eventually forced the Boers out of Natal the damage to the General's reputation had been done and he retired to England under a cloud. The statue was erected in 1905, three years before the General's death from cancer.

It shows his horse 'Biffen' with all its hooves on the ground but although Buller did die from natural causes, apparently it is a myth that the number of hooves in the air gives an indication how a rider died, i.e. in battle, subsequently from wounds received in battle or, as Buller, from natural causes.

Pubs: -

Two more Wetherspoon pubs were opened in July 2009 doubling the number in Exeter. For the early-birds requiring breakfast there is the Chevalier or the much larger Imperial just a few minutes from St David's station.
