

Hastings Old Town – 2nd September 2010

Additional Notes after visit on 24 August :-

Approximate Walking Times :-

Station to 1.	- 5 minutes
Station or 1 to 2	- 15 to 20 minutes
2 to 3	- 6 minutes
3 to 4	- 10 minutes
4 to station	- 15 to 20 minutes

Bus Travel :-

If you are not walking there is a bus every 15 minutes from the station to the old town numbered 20 or 20A destination "Ore Down Farm". The bus usually goes from stand B at the station and your stop is the third en-route or fourth "Roebuck St" if you miss "The Stade". Times are as follows (mins past each hour) :-

Bus No	20	20A	20	20A
Station stop B	08	23	38	53
Old Town The Stade	14	29	44	59

There are additional busses from the station at 15 (100 to Lydd – Stop F) and 50 (344 to Rye/Northiam – Stop F).

When requesting a ticket just ask for the Old Town.
