Itinerary

Breakfast is recommended at our first pub No 11 on the map - Menu attached However for hardened Wetherspoonites there is a Wetherspoon's near Kingston station called the "Kings Tun" – No 24 on the map. CAMRA describe it as a "waiting room for the nightclub opposite"! Lunch can be taken at the "Bishop out of Residence" or the "Druids Head".

1. **Pub No 11 on the map** the "Canbury Arms" 49 Canbury Park Road.
Opens 09.00 – 5minutes walk from the railway/bus station. 5 real ales
Doombar, Landlord, Sussex and 2 local ales

Suggested departure time 11.30 then 10 minutes walk to:-

2. **Pub No 15 on the map** the "Druids Head" 2-3 Market Place.
The only pub left in the market place where once all the buildings around the market were pubs. Dates from 1680. Sky 3D Tv available! along with 4 real ales - Black Sheep, Bonkers, Speckled Hen and Ruddles.

Suggested departure time 12.25 then 5 minutes walk to:-

3. **Pub No 7 on the map** the "Bishop out of Residence" 2 Bishop's Hall. Prominent riverside pub. Upstairs bar affords excellent over the Thames. 5 real ales on – Youngs Special and Ordinary plus 3 guest ales.

Suggested departure time 13.15 then 10 minutes riverside walk to:-

4. **Pub No 8 on the map** the "Boaters Inn" Canbury Gardens.
Modern style pub on the bank of the Thames. 5 real ales on - Adnam's, Brakspears and Hogs Back plus 2 local ales.

Suggested departure time 14.15 then 10 minutes walk to:-

5. **Pub No 20 on the map** the "Grey Horse" 46 Richmond Road.
Blues, Rock and Jazz bands in the evenings. Bar displays music posters and photos of old Kingston. 3 real ales on – Butcombe, Young's Special and Ordinary

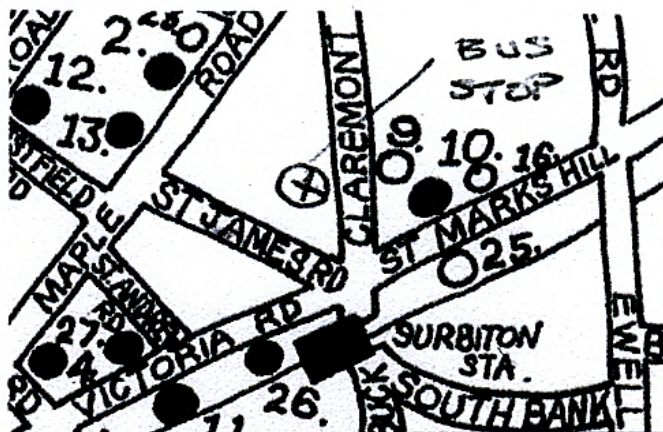

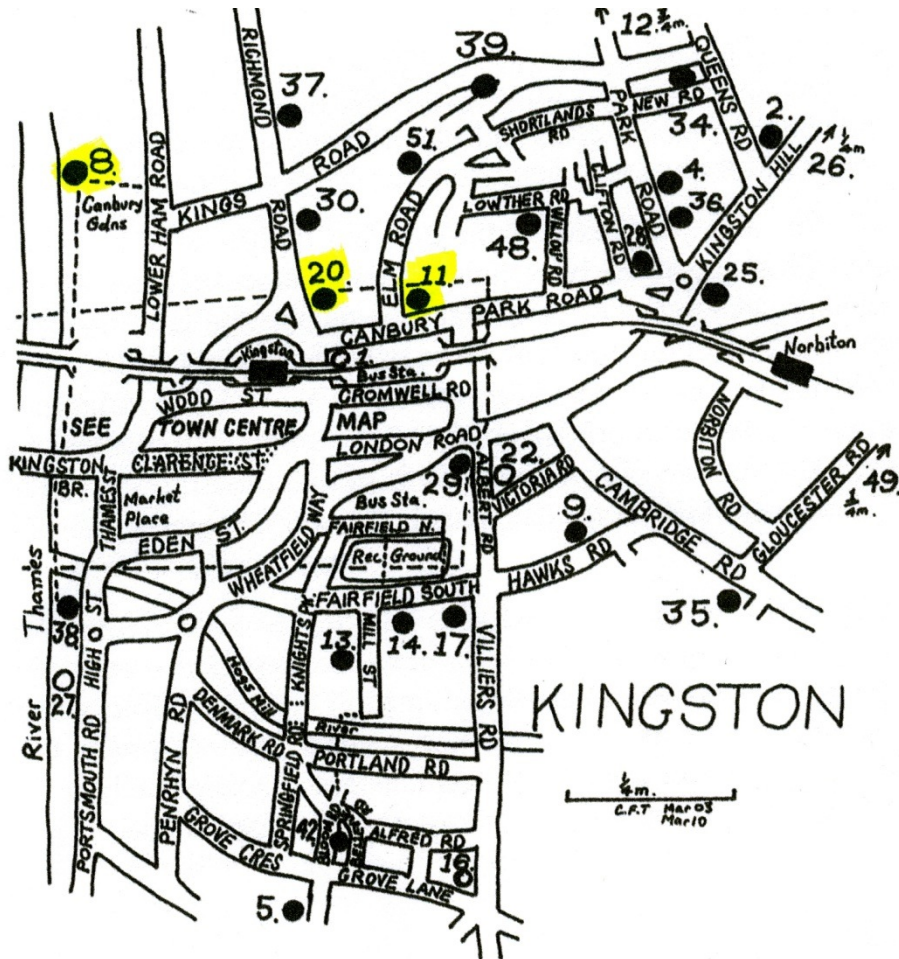
Train and Bus

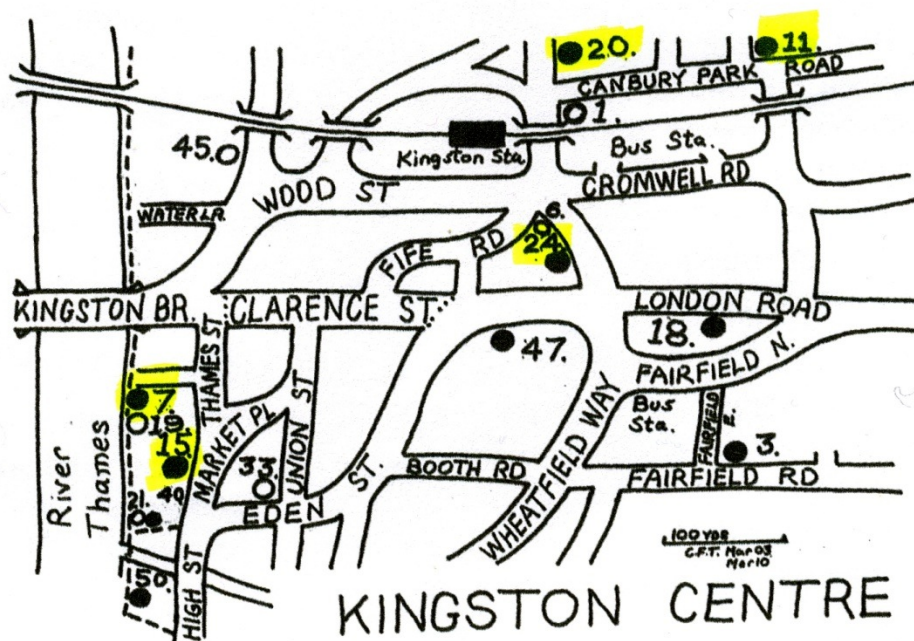

Bus stop location at Surbiton



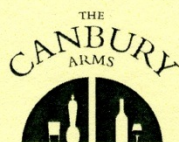
Pub Locations
