oldest building – a 15th Century timber-frame antiques gallery.
Fine historic buildings include the Shire Hall, said to be the inspiration for Jane Austen's Assembly Room at Meryton in Pride And Prejudice, and the oldest Quaker Meeting House in the world, still in use today. Off the main roads, riverside paths

and leafy cul-de-sacs lead to a mix of old cottages and newer housing.

One of Hertford's biggest employ-

ers is the McMullen brewery, estab-lished in 1827. The town has many




