

Jolly Boys Trip to Sheffield - 3rd. March 2011

We have not listed any Wetherspoons because if you catch 0855 from St. Pancras you will need to head for pub 1. Wetherspoons are Swim Inn, 217-231, Glossop Rd., S10 2GW. (tram West St.), The Rawson Spring, Langsett Rd. S6 2LN (Hillsborough Interchange), The Bankers Draft, 1-3, Market Place, S1 2GH. (Castle Square), alright for food but not much else - ran out of lager while we were there. Note National Bus Passes available on the Supertrams after 0900 otherwise there is a day ticket.

The Pubs

Take the tram towards Meadowhall - alight at Woodburn Rd., turn right as you get off the tram and head for the traffic lights in the distance, cross the road and head downhill at the junction opposite

1. Carlton, 563, Attercliffe Road, S9 3RA. 0114 244 3287. 1100. Beer range varies. Built in 1862. A strict no swearing policy. Beers mainly from local brewers, including Clarkes and Wentworth. Only had two Springhead on when we went. About 5 waiting to come on, landlady didn't foresee any problems for our visit. 1100 - 1145. Catch the tram back to (Sheffield) University. £2.30
2. Bath Hotel, 66, Victoria St., S3 7QL. 0114 249 5151. Beer range varies plus a range of continental beers, food. Number 9 on the map (note it is shown in the wrong place should be one street across). From tram walk up hill go down Leagrave St. into Victoria St. 1200ish - 1245 £2.60
3. University Arms, 197, Brook Hill, S3 7HG. 0114 222 8969. 1200. Note this pub was closed on our recce for refurbishment due to reopen on 14th. February so it has been left in. Beer range varies, food. Owned by Sheffield University opened in 2007. Not shown on map but go up Leagrave Rd. towards University tram stop turn right into Hanover St. towards roundabout turn left pub just round the corner in Brook Hill. If by any chance it is still not open back to University Tram and go to Langsett / Primrose View. 1255 - 1330
4. Hillsborough Hotel, 54-58, Langsett Rd., S6 2UB. 0114 232 2100. 1200. Beer range varies but usually has 4 of its own beers plus guests. Number 6 on map. Get tram back to the station. 1345 - 1430
5. Sheffield Tap, Platform 1. Claims most real ales of any pubs in Sheffield. When we went had 5 Thornbridge plus 4 Skinners. Number 14 on map. Certainly had a lot of real ale on but not a lot of choice as far as I was concerned. Snacks. 1445 - end £2.40 -£2.60

Note after number 1 times will be fluid according to what we find on the day.
