To the south is the River Trent, Attenborough and its extensive wetlands.

<u>The Tour</u>

From the station exit up the steps onto Station Road. Turn left and walk up Station Road over 2 main roads (Queens Road and Middle Street). Keep on past the bus station to the pedestrianised street (Chilwell Road). This takes 10 - 15 minutes. Turn left and 100 yards in front of you is:

A – The Last Post, Chilwell Road, NG9 1AA

This is the Weatherspoons in Beeston. We will be here from arrival time to 11:30 (as that is when the next pub opens). It was the old main post office in Beeston. A range of 8 real ales on my visit.

Leave at 11:30 and walk back down Chilwell Road. Cross over and continue down pedestrianised High Road until you get to Union Street. 20 yards down Union Street is:

B – Malt Shovel, 1 Union Street, NG9 2LV

Opens 11:30 but no food until 12:00 (when we leave). 5 real ales.

Stay until 12:00 (ish) then retrace steps past the Last Post. Continue down Chilwell Road. Turn left down Middle Street to reach:

<u>C – The Crown, Church Street, NG9 1FY</u>

This is East Midlands (not just Nottingham) Camra pub of the year for 2010 and is the current Nottingham Camra pub of the year. Opens at 12:00.

14 real ales available but only cobs/snacks for food.

Stay here until 1:00 pm. If people have restless legs then I could guide you down Chilwell Road to the Hop Pole but it isn't as good as the Crown.

Leave at 1:00pm. Cross Middle Street and walk down Dovecote Lane to:

<u>D – The Victoria, 85 Dovecote Lane, NG9 1JG</u>

This is right next to the station (over the footbridge). Generally 12 different real ales it also offers a Camra discount. Main food stop either offering rolls etc or a very good range of home cooked food. Stay here until it is time to go home.
