5.	The Wheatsheaf 24 Southwark St.	Usually 7 -10 on handpump	(GBG 2013).	11.00 - 23.00	12.55 – 13.40
6.	The Old Kings Head	4 beers on handpump mainly from the bigger breweries.	(GBG 2013)	11.00 – 23.00	13.50 -

Food :-

The nearest Wetherspoons is the Pommelers Rest in Tower Bridge Rd. (S side of Tower Bridge) but breakfast is available in either of the two Nicholsons pubs (£6.95 for a full). Otherwise all pubs do food except the Rake.
