Farnham is a town in Surrey within the Borough of Waverly. The town is situated some 42 miles (67 km) southwest of London in the extreme west of Surrey, adjacent to the border with Hampshire. It is a pleasant town with many attractive and historic features. However as you would expect in Surrey, ale and pie prices are rather high!

There is no Wetherspoons or other convenient breakfast opportunity in Farnham so we recommend you eat at a venue of your choice before heading for Farnham. Alternatively it has been suggested that it is feasible to have breakfast at Wetherspoons (Lloyds) in Guildford and complete your journey to Farnham by bus. Details for this will follow shortly.
