Getting There & Back:-

Just make your way to Charing Cross or Embankment for Wetherspoons in Whitehall, or Leicester Square if joining the expedition later.

Return from Charing Cross, Leicester Square, Embankment or walk to Waterloo.

Food :-

All the pubs do lunchtime food so take your choice. Although early eating at a Nicholsons may be the best bet. If we make a second visit to the Harp we will be in time for one of their dog rolls.

The Itinerary :-

Not too much walking so not too bad if wet. There are loads of pubs to choose from but as per usual the order of the first two venues will be adhered to for the benefit of late comers. After The Harp pubs used will depend on ability to get in the door and beers available at time of visit. All pubs are smallish and liable to be crowded.

Don't be surprised at the prices: more than £4.00 a pint is common.

The pubs will be visited in the order in the list, the key numbers on the map do not match the order of visitation of the hostelrys. (Making use of the map used for the Jolly Boys trip in 2009).

Pub 10, The Porcupine. Is just off the map at the junction of Great Newport St and Charing Cross Rd. Adjacent to Leicester Square station.

There are many more pubs nearby including the Marquis (next to the Harp), 4 handpumps: and the Bear and Staff, a Nicholsons pub in Charing Cross Road (5 handpumps) which can be kept as standby venues.

As an alternative for a breakfast Wetherspoons there is also the Moon Under Water, 28 Leicester Square.
