

There are three permanent beers plus at least live guests (often including stouts or porters). Guests are from the Gray's listing and the cider is from the Westons range. There is a charity quiz every fuesday, and rock/blues bands play one Saturday a month. Lunchtime food is served, including Sunday roasts, with a curry night on Thursday evening.
