WALKING: DUE TO ABOVE MENTIONED SITEWORK, BEHIND THE RAILWAY TAVERN, THERE IS NOW NO DIRECT ACCESS TO OR FROM PARK ROAD TO THE RAILWAY STATION OR CENTRAL PARK, A LONGER ROUTE IS AVAILABLE ACROSS THE CONSTRUCTION ROADWAY (ESCORTED BY TRAFFIC MARSHALLS) VIA VICTORIA ROAD SOUTH. A SHORTER ROUTE VIA VIADUCT ROAD IS RECOMMENDED.

NEWLY PLANTED SHRUBS - GREENERY NEAR CRICKET GROUND IN NEW WRITTLE STREET ADD A FEW YARDS TO THE ROUTE TO/FROM RAILWAY STATION: SEE MAP FOR DETAILS.

A newly opened conversion of three railway arches facing the side of Chelmsford bus station. Twelve handpumps dispense continually changing beers, often from Adnams, Sharp's and Black Sheep, with the rest from anywhere, always including dark beers and stronger beers. The manager is a fan of more hoppy beers so one or two of these always feature. Five or six varied real ciders are sold. Food is baguettes, soup and pizzas lunchtimes, and pizzas and cheese/meat plates evenings (no food Sun). A microbrewery is planned. ☎♻♻♻♻

The back bar is quieter. Three guest ales are offered, with an emphasis on Essex breweries. It has a covered outdoor patio area for smokers. Live music is on the first Saturday of the month and there is a soul music DJ on the third Saturday. No food Sunday evening. ☎♻♻♻♻ (100,42)

The Orange Tree is one of the best real ale pubs in Chelmsford and was runner-up local CAMRA Pub of the Year 2012 and 2013. There are three permanent beers plus at least five guests (often including stouts or porters). Guests are from the Gray's listing and the cider is from the Westons range. There is a charity quiz every Tuesday, and rock/blues bands play one Saturday a month. Lunchtime food is served, including Sunday roasts, with a curry night on Thursday evening. ☎♻♻♻♻♻♻
