Culture :-

Loads of culture. A pre-roman settlement then a roman camp and market town (Noviomagus). When the Romans departed about 477AD the Saxon chief Aella landed in England and gave the settlement to his son Cissa and it became known as Cissa's Ceaster (Chichester). It became a cathedral city in Norman times and the cathedral was started in 1091. Naturally there are many historic edifices, notably including Ivan Olney and Alan Green.

The Pubs :-

There are very few pubs in Chichester considering it is a cathedral City, but there are 4 now in the GBG so worth a visit. A & B are possible pubs en-route to the Bell.

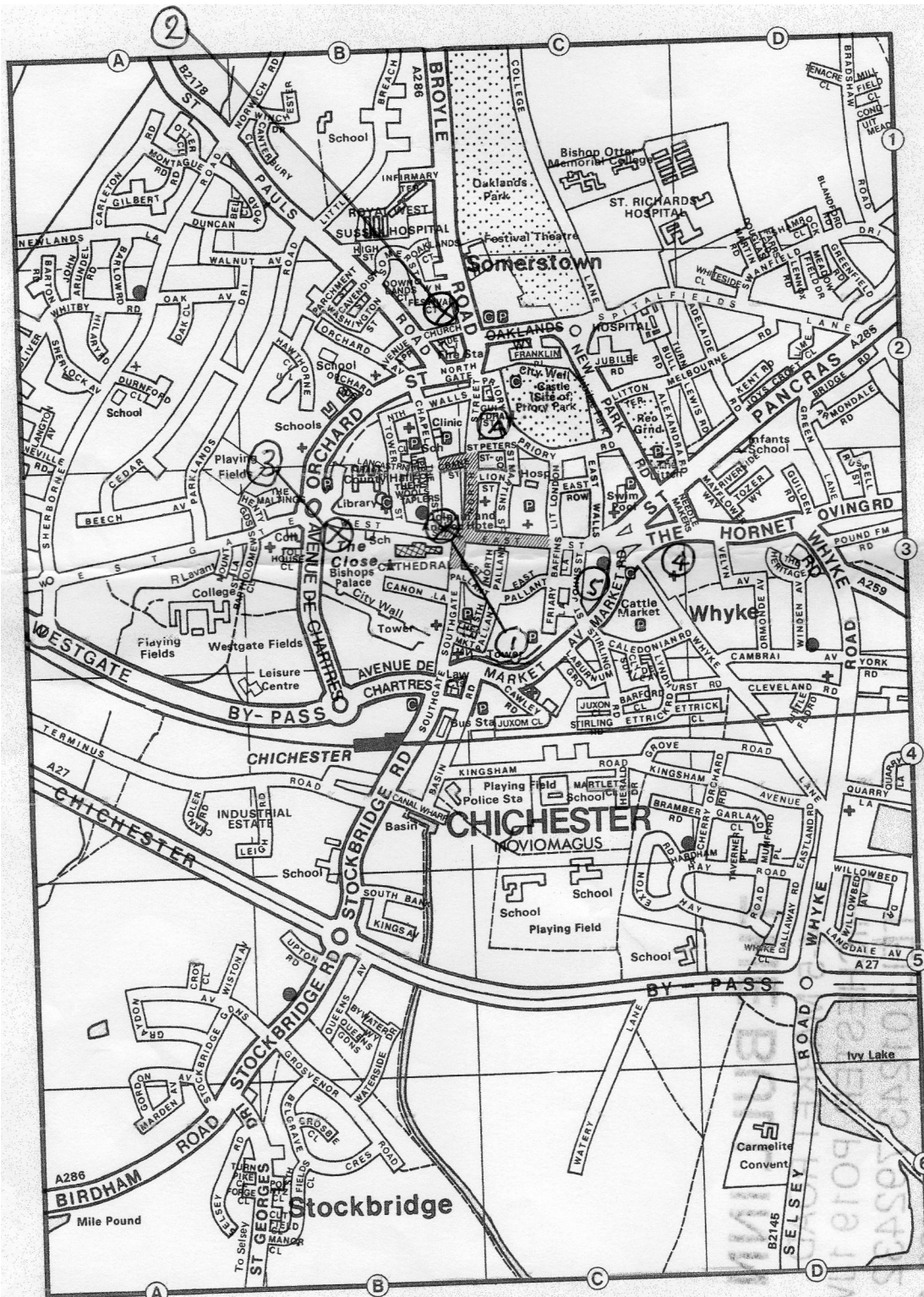
