Getting into town

As most of you know Derby Town Centre is not near the station. The first option is to walk following the route on the maps (incidentally the maps do join up but at a displacement) to pub 1. This takes about 20-30 minutes. The alternative is to catch a bus from the brand new bus stop outside the station. The bus is an RL1 which runs every 15 minutes (08 23 38 53) to the bus station (shown on the map). It is then about 10-15 minutes to pub 1.

Incidentally there is a limited bus service at the moment as a bridge over the railway is being replaced (look left as you come into the station from the south) and most buses are being diverted.

6+ real ales No food

Stay until 12.00 (to give time for next pub to open)

Exeter Arms 13 Exeter Place DE1 2EU (No 3 on map)

Dancing Duck Brewery beer plus guests. Does food but it is quite expensive.

Stay until 12.40.

Smithfield Meadow Road, DE1 2BH (No 4 on map)

This was closed last time but is now refurbished and open. 7+ real ales. Has a good range of reasonably priced food and is the recommended food stop.

Stay until 13.30.

Alexandrea Hotel 203 Siddals Road, DE1 2QE (No 5 on map)

Put into the tour as you all went in there last time when it wasn't. Castle Rock Beer plus guests.

Stay until 14.00 (or whatever).

The Brunswick Inn 1 Railway Terrace DE1 2RU (No 6 on map)

Traditional end to a Derby tour.

Stay until you go home.
