Not been able to find any pubs, other than Wetherspoons open before 1200. Also food is in short supply apart from 2 Wetherspoons, although there are various food outlets such as a fish and chip shop next to the Duke William.

Meet up in The Chequers Inn,95, High St., DY8 1EQ. 01384 398670 (Wetherspoons). Catch the Parry People Carrier from Stourbridge Junction to Stourbridge Town. Come out of the station and head across the road towards the bus station. Follow the signs towards Town Centre. When you exit into the town walk a few yards to Barclay's Bank, turn left and the Chequers is up on the right. Leave at roughly 1150. Head back towards the bank and go straight down to the Square.

There is a pub there called the Mitre, allegedly opens at 1000, CAMRA website says 1200 Ken's phone says 1000, we didn't try it but we went in and it had 3 handpumps with reasonable looking beers on, can't guarantee what may be on on the day. Could be additional stop.

Turn tight into Coventry St. and up to the Duke William DY8 1EP the home of Craddock Brewery opens at 1200. Had about 5 real ales on also does various pies and mash. Leave about 1250.

Turn right out of pub go straight across the square and follow the walkway under the main road. Up the ramp into Enville St. Royal Exchange 75 Enville St., DY8 1XW, Opens at 1300 sells Bathams Bitter and Mild. Back to Stourbridge Town (leave 1330) then catch 1350 from Stourbridge Town to Junction to Lye.

Go up the ramp and turn left to Windsor Castle (Sadler's Brewery Tap) 5, Stourbridge Rd., DY9 7DG (at Lye Cross). About 300 yards up on the right. We have been here before on one of Roger's bus trips Full range of Sadler's beers.
