My original intention was that we start the tour in the Buckingham Arms outside of Shoreham station where there used to be a café for fodder. The café has gone, now a Pizza establishment and the pub does not now open till 11-30 so its Worthing only today. I had then planned to take you back to a number of pubs which you have enjoyed before. Unfortunately some of these are now closed and others are, in my opinion, no longer worthy of CAMRA accreditation. I have therefore spent some time on the web searching for recommended suitable close at hand alternatives. These pubs, which I have not visited are marked*

Don't worry this is the last.

There are two J D Wetherspoons in Worthing within 150 yards of each other. I am suggesting we start in the larger of the two,

- (1) The Sir Timothy Shelley, 59 Chapel Street.
Usual range of beer and food, if beer range limited try across road at No 56.
Leave 11-15
- (2)* The Spyglass 31a Marine Parade
3 Anchor Brewery Beers plus 1 guest
11-20 till 11-55
- (3)* The Wandering Goose 18 Marine Parade
(Real Ale and Craft Beer Pub opened Nov 2013)
12-00 till 12-30
- (4) Seldon Arms 41 Lyndhurst Road
On day of visit following beers offered Hank from Tiny Rebel, Indian from Bristol Brewery, Whole Hearted from Oakleaf, Flack Catcher from Flack Manor, Plateau from Burning Sky and Smelters Stout.
Recommended Nosh Stop
12-40 till 13-45

- (5) The Swan Inn 79 High Street
On day of visit following beers offered Otter, Hogsback TEA, Arundel and Harveys
Wait for it SUB WARNING (a) Landlord of (4) reckons this boozer is in trouble.
Proposed visiting time 13-50 till 14-30ish however if closed see below
- (5a)* Grand Victorian Hotel, Railway Approach (50 yards to platforms)
Only if (5) closed. Usually stocks two reasonable beers
