centre around the castle is a substantial Conservation Area, with 17th Century inns, Queen Anne, Georgian and Regency townhouses and Hertford's oldest building - a 15th Century timber-frame antiques gallery.

Fine historic buildings include the Shire Hall, said to be the inspiration for Jane Austen's Assembly Room at Meryton in *Pride and Prejudice*, and the oldest Quaker Meeting House in the world, still in use today.

Off the main roads, riverside paths and leafy cul-de-sacs lead to a mix of old cottages and newer housing. One of Hertford's biggest employers is the McMullen brewery, established in 1827. The town has many

antiques shops and hairdressers, while new cafes and bars cater to the growing population of 26,000.

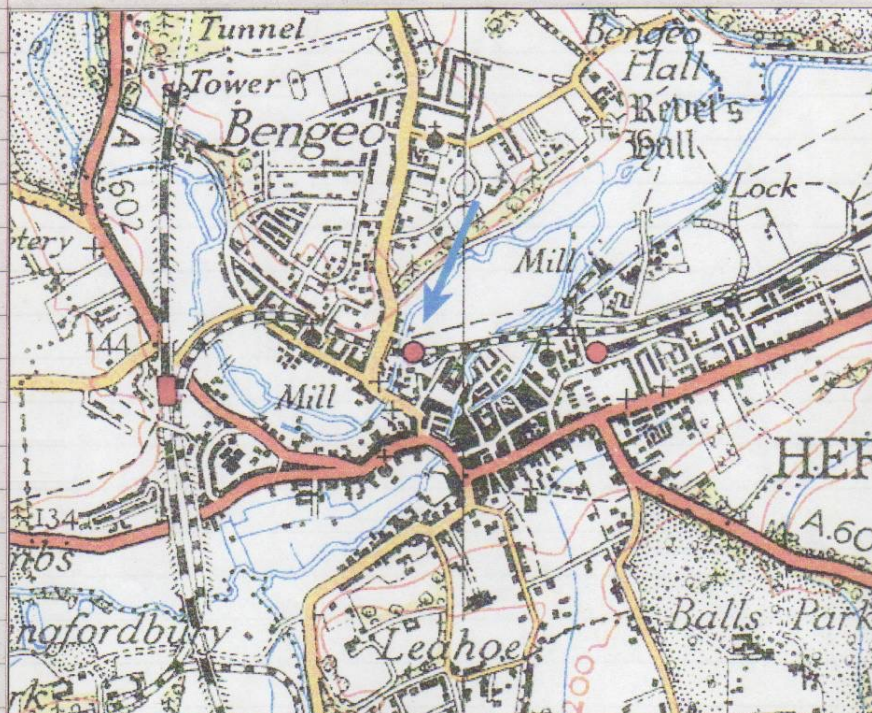

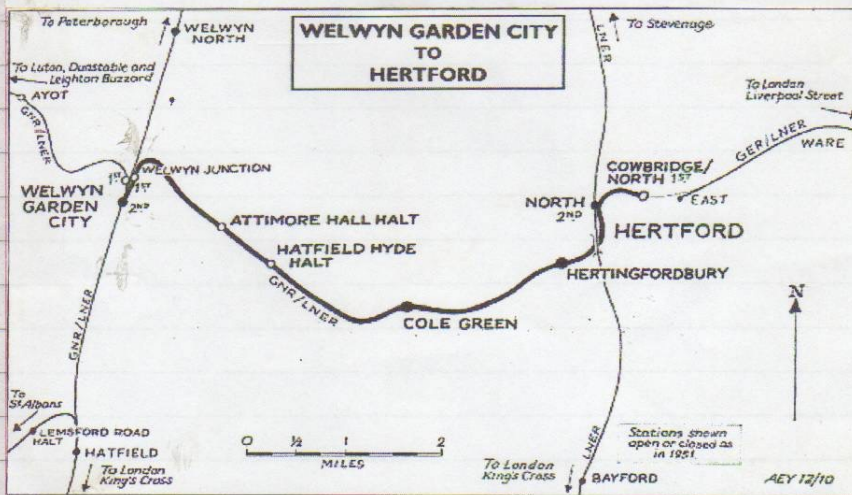

Dating from the 15th century with later additions, Lombard House, on the River Lea, was built as an English Hall House and is one of the oldest buildings in Hertford. It has been the home of the private members' club since 1897. CAMRA members are welcome and can be signed in on production of a membership card. You will find three ever-changing beers and real cider, which in summer can be enjoyed in the delightful walled garden. An open acoustic club on Sunday evenings is well supported.
