By Bus

Come out of the station on upside and cross road 50 yards to the left for buses (Ranelagh Road) to Tower Rampart's Bus Station.

There are 9 buses per hour taking between 7 to 14 minutes.

Walking Approximately 1 mile

The Pubs

Directions - This pub is opposite the bus station

1) The Cricketers (Wetherspoons) 51 Crown Street – G.B.G

Opens: 8:00AM

J.B's Times: until 10:55am

Directions – Turn Left and Turn 2nd Left into Fontenbeau Road. The Turn Right into Christ Church Park, keep Right and out of entrance, then Turn Left at Tuddenham Road to the Wool Pack (900 yards).

2) The Woolpack – 1 Tuddenham Road – G.B.G

Opens: 09:30am

J.B's Times: 11:05am to 11:50am

Info: 5 Ales + food

Come out of the pub and go straight on until the end, Turn Left into Woodbridge Road to pub No. 3 (800 yards).

3) Mulberry Tree - 5 Woodbridge Road - G.B.G

Opens: 12:00pm

J.B's Times: 12:00pm to 12:40pm

Info: At least 6 Ales, but NO Food.

Cross the road to the opposite side and go down Upper Orwell Street which goes into Fore Street to pub No.4 (800 yards)

4) Briarbank Tap - 70 Fore Street - G.B.G

Opens: 12:00pm

J.B's Times: 12:50pm to 1:30pm

Info: All beers are brewed on the premises. Please have C.A.M.R.A Cards with you.

To enter premises ring bell on side.

Turn Right and cross the road and Turn Left into Grimwade Street and go down some way to Saint Helen's Street and Turn Right to Pub No. 5 (800 yards).

5) Dove Street Inn - 76 St Helen's Street - G.B.G

Opens: 12:00pm

J.B's Times: 1:40pm to End

Info: At least 6 Ales and the best place for Food.

Buses (Return journey) - Buses go from outside the pub every 15 minutes (No. 66), 00, 15, 30, 45 and takes between 10-20 Minutes depending on the traffic to the Railway Station.

Walking – Takes about 25 Minutes.
