Bus no 4 from stop across road from station leaves at :04 :16 :28 :40 :52 journey time 5 mins alight outside the Laurence Sheriff School just after bus has gone round a roundabout for either JDW (cross road at lights and walk along in direction bus was travelling, then across carpark} or the Vic (return past the roundabout and cross Whitehill Rd. the Vic is 50 yards further on across road.)
