Given that all of this experimentation and innovation has taken place when beer sales in total in Britain have been in decline, the drinkers of Sheffield can count them selves very fortunate that the, range, choice and diversity of beers on offer to them from local brewers has never been greater.

David Wickett - Owner of Kelham Island Brewery and the Fat Cat pub. The Pubs. (unless otherwise stated all pubs open at 1200; bus passes are accepted on the trams; make sure your pass is valid and up to date)

- Benjamin Huntsman 12-18, Cambridge St., S1 4HP. Large 2 storey Wetherspoons pub opposite John Lewis. Named after the inventor of Crucible Steel. 0730. Tram - City Hall Leave about 1050.
- 2. Head of Steam (formerly the Old Monk), 103 107, Norfolk St., S1 2JE. A large split level bar located in a converted bank. 4 changing beers from Camerons with guests from Yorkshire and the North East. 1100. Tram Cathedral. Catch tram to University leave at 1110.
- 3. University Arms, 197, Brook Hill, S3 7HG. Previously Sheffield University staff club, converted to a pub in 2007. Left of the entrance is the bar and small alcove seating area, with the larger lounge area on the right. The conservatory leads to an extensive beer garden. 6 guest beers. Tram University. Food but tends to crowded lunch time. Leave 1300. Walk to
- 4. Red Deer, 18 Pitt Street, City Centre, Sheffield: Central, S1 4DD. (0114) 272 2890 red-deer-sheffield.co.uk 12-Midnight Mon-Thu; 12-1 Fri & Sat; 12-11 Sun A traditional back street pub in the heart of the city, with a good selection of local and regional guest ales. Good value food menu, Catch tram back to the station.
- 5. Sentinel Brewing Company, 178 Shoreham Street, Sheffield, S1 4SQ. (0114) 399 9888 sentinelbrewing.co . Lies in a courtyard like an abandoned garage. It is also bright yellow (or it was when we went) Brewhouse with bar. Opening Times Closed Mon; 11-11 Tue-Thu; 11-Midnight Fri & Sat; 11-10 Sun. Meal Times Closed Mon; 12-10 Tue-Sat; 12-5 Sun. Impressive conversion of an industrial shed type building that used to be a carpet showroom, now home to Sentinel's brewery and tap bar where beer is taken seriously! There are six handpumps on the bar showcasing the range including both core and seasonal beers, served in a choice of measures 1/3, 1/2, 2/3 or pint and served in appropriate glassware for the style of beer. Food includes stone baked pizzas, tapas and main meals.
- 6. The Sheffield Tap, Platform 1b, Sheffield Railway Station, Sheaf St., S1 2BP. 1100. 7 changing beers. Tram Sheffield Station.
