Sheffield) **H**

Dating from 1796, this stone-built former coaching inn has an L-shaped split-level bar warmed by a real fire. Up to eight ales, complemented by a good range of European bottled beers, are available. As many as seven ciders and perries, often from Broadoak, are on offer. Beer festivals are held at Easter and in September on the secluded patio, which boasts a mounting block from the days when visitors arrived on horseback. The pub has much beer memorabilia adorning the walls.

Brewster's Marquis; Oakham JHB; 4 changing beers (often Grainstore, Magpie, Tydd Steam) 

A stone-built inn dating from 1830, comprising an L-shaped room surrounding the bar and an adjoining small room that serves as a dining area. Outside is a large paved area with tables. The home-cooked food is locally sourced. The pub is home to pool, darts, crib and dominoes teams from the local community. Beers from six handpumps come from local and countrywide brewers. One handpump serves cider, usually Old Rosie. A good range of malt whiskies is available.

Adnams Southwold Bitter; Castle Rock Harvest Pale; 3 changing beers (sourced regionally; often Adnams, Colchester, Moonshine) 

The building, parts of which date back to 1280, was bought by Tobie Norris in 1617 and used as a brewery. A conversion into a pub from the former RAFA Club gained it CAMRA's Conversion to Pub Use Award in 2007. It is split into many small rooms with real fires, stone floors and low beams. Five handpumps serve beers from local and countrywide brewers, and two beer festivals are held each year. At least one real cider is always available. 🍷🍺🍻🍾 (202, 203) 🐾

STN TO ①. APPROX. 600YDS: EARLIES - LEAVE 11.05HRS  
STATION ROAD, LEFT INTO HIGH STREET, LEFT INTO  
BROWNLOW STREET, LEFT INTO CASTLE DYKE, RIGHT INTO  
ST PETERS VALE - SHEEP MARKET (NEAR CASTLE)

① TO ②. APPROX. 300YDS: 11.15HRS - LEAVE 12.05HRS  
LEFT INTO ST. PETERS VALE, LEFT INTO ST. PETERS  
STREET, RIGHT INTO WEST STREET, FOUNDARY ~~STREET~~ <sup>ROAD</sup> ON LEFT.

② TO ③. APPROX. 250YDS: 12.10HRS - LEAVE 13.05HRS  
RETURN TO WEST STREET, TURN LEFT AT JUNCTION  
OF SCOTGATE, TURN LEFT THEN 100YDS.

③ TO ④. APPROX. 600YDS: 13.15HRS - UNTIL ?  
FROM GREEN MAN TURN RIGHT INTO SCOTGATE,  
CONTINUE INTO ST. GEORGES SQUARE, TURN LEFT INTO  
HIGH STREET, CONTINUE TO SAINT PAULS STREET.

④ TO STN. APPROX. 600YDS.  
TURN RIGHT INTO ST. PAULS STREET, CONTINUE TO HIGH  
STREET, TURN LEFT INTO MAIDEN LANE, RIGHT INTO  
SAINT MARY'S ~~LANE~~ <sup>STREET</sup>, LEFT INTO ST. MARYS HILL / HIGH ST,  
STATION ROAD ON RIGHT.
