# Jolly Boys Visit Wivenhoe/ Colchester 7th July

# Culture

Wivenhoe was formerly a port (closed 1992) and boat builder( closed 1986) when it was a busy town, but now is a dormantry town for commuters to London. In place of the port they built a very tasteful housing development.

In 1886 they built a branch line to Brightlingsea (now closed) to carry fish, particularly oysters, which could be despatched quickly to London.

### **Travel information.**

I suggest making your own arrangements for breakfast as there is only one through train to Wivenhoe per hour. You can catch any train to Colchester, then get no 62 bus from outside downside entrance these are every 15 mins and take 37 mins as they have to go via Colchester town centre.

Get off at the Greyhound pub (not open until 12) follow road down past church, turn left it passes fish and chip shop on left and Miss Maple's (Joan Hickson) cottage is on your right, (blue plaque) on wall bear right and pub no 1 is ahead of you. From Wivenhoe station go over footbridge turn left into station rd, turn right and follow same instructions as above from bus.
