Northampton 2nd March 2017

This trip was devised entirely using What Pub and Google Maps Street view with a recce on Jan 26th. After a talk with the barman at Albion bar I got some recommendations for a future trip the other side of the town centre. The Moon on the Square and Malt Shovel were on our last visit in 2000. The King Billy which we visited then is also still in existence but the others are not in What Pub, since discovered they have been renamed.

Smokers beware: outside facilities are in short supply.

The pubs

There are buses 9/9A at 03,13,23,33,43,53 from the bottom of the steps at the station; two stops to Drapery. Others seem to go to the bus station North Gate round the corner at the top of Drapery; 1 minute walk from JDW.

From the station walk down the steps and straight on into Mare Fair with runs into Gold Street; at the end by All Saints Church curve left into Drapery turn right by Cancer Research, JDW on left in 10 yards. Just over 1/4 mile.

If you are going straight to no 2 go to the right of All Saints Church into George St and ahead into St Giles Square then along front of Guildhall into St Giles St. Pub on left.

1 Moon on the Square JDW Usual fare.

Leave 11:00 Walk diagonally across Market Square, (it is market day) down the side of Paddy Power into Wood Hill left into St Giles Square, along front of Guildhall into St Giles

Leave 12:45 back to corner left then next left into Guildhall St, right into Angel St. Left down Bridge St. Keep on left footpath. On right at bottom, where traffic comes up and round to left is No 3 next to King Bills Rock bar visited in 2000.

- 4 Malt Shovel 121, Bridge St. <u>maltshoveltavern.com</u> 01604-234212 Visited in 2000, opens 11:30 !0 ales on offer. Baguettes, Sandwiches, Wraps. Leave when you like back straight along to Station.

Walk back to station. Cross road outside Malt Shovel keep round Carlsberg, at next roundabout cross one road then continue up on this side until opposite the station. Allow a good 10 minutes.
