Wetherspoons (City Hall Tram) go through alleyway and past City Hall. The pub is opposite John Lewis. Leave at 1050.

University Arms, 197, Brook Hill, Broomhall, S3 7HG. 1100. 0114 222 8969. Owned by the University of Sheffield. Leave about 1145. Guest beers are mostly local. Get tram to Shalesmoor. From here times are flexible so we can suit ourselves.

Shakespeare's Ale and Cider House, 146-148, Gibraltar St., S3 8UB. 0114 275 5959. 1200 Built in 1821 opened as a free house in 2011. The 8 handpumps have featured more than 4000 beers over the last 5 years, and over 100 whiskies are also stocked. 8 changing beers. www.shakespeares-sheffield.co.uk

Kelham Island Tavern, 62, Russell St., S3 8RW. 1200. 0114 272 2482. <u>www.kelhamtavern.co.uk</u> Former CAMRA national pub of the year. Was rescued from dereliction in 2002. 12 hand pumps always feature a mild, a porter and a stout. Beer garden.

Fat Cat, 23, Alma st., S3 8SA. 1200, 0114 2494801. Opened in 1981, started the real ale revolution in the area. Features beer from the adjacent Kelham Island Brewery. www.thefatcat.co.uk

The Harlequin, 108, Nursery St., S3 8GG. 1130.
