Leave, turn left, walk 250 yards to bus stop at corner of Pavilion Buildings for a No 7 to the Royal Sussex County Hospital, Eastern Road (7 stops) That ain't to difficult is it? .Late comers just get the No7 from the station and go direct to the hospital. But don't book in.

You are now in Corona V land yes a certain guy got quarantined there. Get off bus, cross road and look for Upper Sudley Place. Walk down 150 yards, turn left into Sudley St and proceed 150 yards to

Location 2 St Georges Inn 33 Sudley St 12-00 to 12-30.

They advertise they are big on beers. Rotates between Adnams, Tim T, Dark Star, Mad Goose & Firebird. Here's the rub discount only if you are a NHS worker. (because of nearby hospital)

Leave pub, back track to road junction, 150 yards, cross into St Georges Road, a fairly busy through fare. Walk for about 6 minutes . On your left you will see the,

Location 3 Barley Mow 92 St Georges Rd 12-40 to 13-20 ${\bf FOOD}$ (Piemiinsters & Pizzas)

5 Ever changing beers including Black Sheep & Harvestoun On leaving turn left proceed down St Georges Rd and cross over into

Location 4 The Thomas Kemp 8 St Georges Rd-13-25 to 14-00 **FOOD** (Variety menu)

Beers on day, Gunn, Laine and Pedigree.

Leave turn left walk into Upper St James St (same road) cross to the

Location 5 Hand in Hand 23 Upper St James St 14-05 till end or until punters wish to go the station area for an additional drink.

A quirky little corner pub which plays french radio station music.

Interesting beers. Old hands have been here before possibly 10-15 years ago, may be more my memory isn't what it was.

To return to station leave pub, , cross road, walk up any road to Edward St about 250 yards. Catch No7 to station.

Should you wish to further imbibe pick any pub within 300 yards of the station

Trains, if working. loads to London .and onward for travelling north, for Guildford and west through Reading any to Gatwick, , Routes along Coastways West and East also available. You can't go wrong he says.
