

Jolly Boys Swindon – 9th January 2020

Swindon town is split into two distinct areas – Old Town and New Town and our Jolly Boys takes in both. Unfortunately this involves a bus ride between them.

For those early enough we start in The Sir Daniel (Weatherspoons) for breakfast but will have to leave at 10.39 to catch the 10.49 up to Old Town else there is a half hour wait for the next bus at 11.19.

I have marked up the walking route on the map for both the pub and the bus stop which is above the underpass on Flemings Way.

Get off bus at Prospect Place which is at top of Victoria Road. Return bus to Fleming Way in New Town is opposite side of road.

Buses

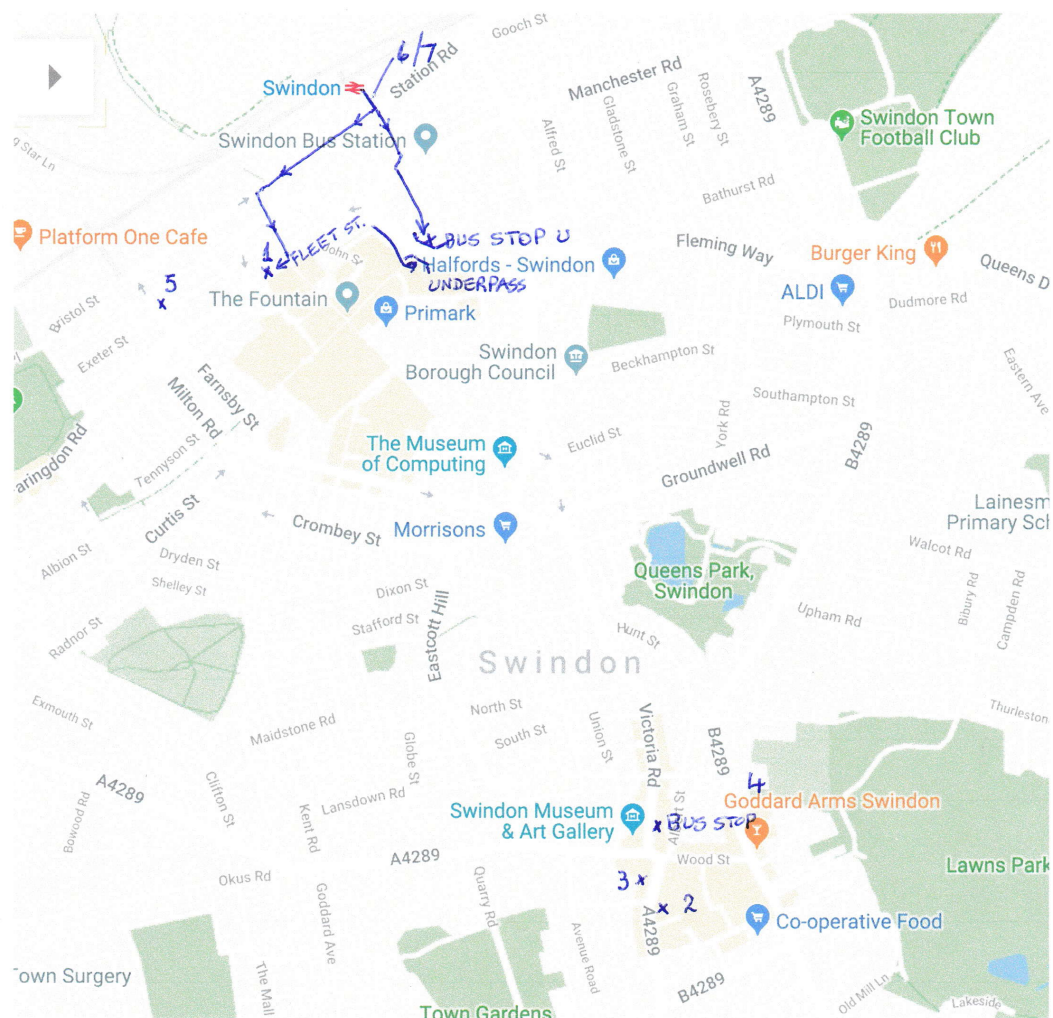
No 22 from Bus stop U in Fleming Way depart 10.49/11.19 arrive 10.53/11.23
