

Chappel and Wakes Colne Beer Festival.

Here are the details as put out by the organisers for anyone planning to go.

- 1:- Dates and Times: Tue 7 Sept open 17:00 to 23:00, and Wed 8 Sept to Sat 11 Sep 11:00 to 23:00
- 2:- Admission: You will need to buy an ticket in advance – no ticket no admission. There will not be tickets on sale on the door.
Tickets will be sold in two sessions each day (one on Tuesday). The tickets are valid for entry from 11:00 to 17:30 for the first session and the second for entry 17:30 to 23:00.
Ticket Prices will be announced on the 1st and we will be selling a combined Ticket and your 1st beer card "starter pack" ticket. Any unused money on a beer card will be refunded, it will be a cash refund due to the constraints refunding to cards. We are NOT charging a glass deposit, but we will NOT have a collectable glass, it will be old stock.
- 3:- Beer Choice: It WILL be a reduced choice, we are planning on having over 100 beers and many ciders, but it will not be the 400 or so we normally have .
- 4:- Children: While we normally welcome children, this year building works means there is not going to be many places to play and children may get bored easily. A baby sitter may be a better choice both for your and your children's enjoyment.
- 5:- Pets: Just like children please consider if a small yard with lots of people will be a good place for animals. Dogs must be kept on a lead & any mess cleaned up afterwards.
- 6:- Music: – There will be NO BANDS playing on any night.
- 7:- Food: As we are smaller there will be a smaller range of food offers, you will not go hungry but may not have the usual choice. There WILL be Vegetarian and Vegan options but these do sell out, & cannot be guaranteed at all times.
- 9:- Public camping: There is NO public camping
- 10:- Money: We will use our usual "Strike Card" system, if you want to buy more beer cards, payment by contactless methods is much preferred to cash, please be advised to try and bring a suitable card.
