A return to Loughborough after 9 years (I think). Unfortunately it has been impossible to find a pub that meets Jolly Boy standards that opens at 11.00 so we will be staying in the Weatherspoons until 11.55. You may choose to travel later if that is an issue. I can direct you to a pub (across the road) if you want a pint of Pedigree.

Anyway:

Arriving at Loughborough

It is a 20 minute walk from the station (top right on map 1) to the town centre. However there is a shuttle service from the station to town. Turn right out of the station to the first bus stand. It is the Kinchbus Sprint. This runs every 10 minutes starting on the hour (it is now term time) and takes 5 minutes and drops you off at point A which is outside the Weatherspoons. There are other buses but none so convenient.

The Pubs

1. The Amber Rooms, 15 The Rushes, LE11 5BE (A on map 1)

We remain here until 11.55.

2. White Hart, 27 Churchgate, LE11 1UD (B on map 1)

A Charnwood Pub with 3 Charnwood ales plus 2 guests. Does food (Sandwiches and Burgers).

Remain until 12.40.

3. The Three Nuns, 30 Church Gate, LE11 1UD (C on map 1)

Next door but one to White Hart. An Everards pub with 4 Everard ales plus guests. Does pub food plus sandwiches.

Remain until 13.15.

4. The Organ Grinder, 4 Woodgate, LE11 2TY (E on map 2)

Blue Monkey tied house. 6 Blue Monkey ales but no guests. No food.

Remain until 13.45.

(Alternative with less walking is to go straight to No 5)

5. The Swan in the Rushes, 21 The Rushes, LE11 5BE (D on map 1)

Opposite the Amber Rooms. Castle Rock pub with 7+ ales. No food.

The bus stop back to the station is outside this pub which is why this is at the end.
