

Jolly Boys trip to Sevenoaks - subject to change following recce on 10 March.

Hopefully this trip will give you all a taste of some of the smaller Kent Breweries beers, however being Kent you can't get away from Shepherd Neame!

This trip entails the use of the local omnibus to take us from the Station up into Sevenoaks town.

On leaving the station cross the road and catch either bus no 1, 308, 8 leaving approx. 0952, 1017 1050 arriving at Sevenoaks Bus Station approx. 0956, 1021, 1055. On alighting from the bus head towards the High Street and turn right, follow the road down and the **Sennockian** (Weatherspoons) is on the left. Leave at 1115hrs.

Exit the pub and turn right and walk up the High Street until you reach the junction keep turning right into London Road and the **Chequers** is on the right. Serves Tonbridge and Westerham beers, both local and from Kent as well as Harveys and St Austell. Leave at 1200hrs.

At this point we have a choice of either the Anchor or the Restoration – it all depends on whether you want to eat and/or drink Shepherd Neame beers. For both options exit the pub and turn right, walk down London Road and on the right is the **Anchor** and down a small lane on the right is the **Restoration**.

The **Anchor** sells Wantsum and Ramsgate beers – both brewed in Kent – and does food. Leave at 1245hrs or when you have eaten.

The **Restoration** is a Shepherd Neame pub so only sells their beers but does do food. A selection of main meals and sandwiches reasonably priced for the area. Leave at 1315hrs for drinkers or when you have eaten.

From either pub exit and turn left down the lane back to the High Street where you turn left back towards the bus station, which you pass, onto the **Oak Tavern and Tap**. A microbrewery which also serves Westerham beers. Leave at 1400hrs at the latest so you can catch the no 1 or 8 bus back to the Rail Station. If you miss the 1417 bus the next one is at 1500hrs!

Alight at the rail Station and continue on over the railway bridge crossing the road to the **Halfway House** where there is a selection of Westerham Ales. Leave when ever.
