## Jolly Boys trip to Tonbridge – 26 May 2022

Turn left on leaving the station and walk up through the town until you reach, on your left,

1 - Humphrey Bean - Weatherspoon's for those who want breakfast. Leave at 1100hrs

Turn left on leaving and walk uphill, not steep, crossing over the river Medway and then cross over the High Street to

**2 – The Rose and Crown** - serves Harvey's and one changing beer, Proper Job on day of recce. Leave at **1130hrs** 

Turn right out of pub and continue on up the High Street to the

**3** – Ivy House – serves Harvey's and one changing beer, Pig and Porter on day of recce. Leave at 1200hrs

Turn left on leaving going back down the High Street to the

**4 – Fuggles Beer Café** – serves Tonbridge Coppernob and 3 changing beers, Burnt Hill Present Tense and Iron Pier. A good selection of interesting cask beers is also available. This is a possible lunch stop where a selection of sandwiches, toasties, ploughman's and cheeses and chacuterie can be obtained. Leave at **1245hrs** 

Turn left on leaving and cross over the High Street and walk down the hill to the

**5** – **Chequers\*** – serves Harvey's and Tribute. This is another option for lunch where meals can be purchased as well as good value baguettes. Leave at **1330hrs** 

Turn right on leaving going on down the High Street crossing over the river Medway to the

**6 – Beer Seller** – serves 3 regular beers, Celler Head Session Pale Ale, Constellation Draco and Goachers Gold Strong Ale as well as other local to Tonbridge beers. Leave when you want.

To get back to the station turn right on leaving and it is about a 6 or 7 min walk.

\*the Chequers can be missed and either spend more time in Fuggles Beer Café or go onto the Beer Seller where there is a greater selection of different beers to be found in both venues.
