We have visited Bath on numerous occasions and this time we will mainly stay close to The Abbey and Pulteney Bridge, which obviously means 'tourist prices'. The Architect is a Brunning and Price bar/ eatery on the ground floor of the Empire Hotel that only opened in July last year. Number 4, the Raven, is a bit away from the others but has been included for a change of beers and its lunch menu.
