Beers available on day of recce. Horns Brewing company ; Hopadelic Youngs Special Youngs ordinary Leave 11.45. <u>5 minutes to pub 3</u>

3. <u>Ram</u>

Beers available on day of recce. Timothy Taylor Landlord St Austell Tribute Rammed Wimbledon Common Leave 12.25. <u>5 minutes to pub 4</u>

4. Druids Head (Food available-Probably the best option)

Outbreak of Green King here but 6 other Guest ales available that will all have changed by the time we visit Leave 13.15. <u>10-15 minutes to pub 5</u>


5. Boaters Inn* (Food available)
