
JOLLY BOYS AROUND KINGS CROSS AND ST. PANCRAS THURSDAY 12th DECEMBER 2024

The Pubs

1. The Barrel Vault Wetherspoons St Pancras International Station-N1C 4QP At the station you will find it at the bottom the escalator to the Kent High Speed platforms.

JB Times until 11.40

2. **King Charles 1,** 55-57 Northdown St N1 9BL Opens 12.00. 4 changing real ales, mainly sourced locally.

A nationally important historic interior dating from the 1930's. The pub was saved in 2015 thanks to the support of passionate local people. It is now community owned. Food bought locally can be delivered and devoured at the pub. Open fire in winter.

JB Times 12.00-12.30

3. The Queen's Head, 66 Acton Street, WC1X 9NB. Opens 12.00 Little Victorian pub. Regularly changing real ales on 3 handpumps. Serves food i.e. pork pies, cured meats and cheeses.

4. The Skinners' Arms, 114 Judd Street. WC1H 9NT Opens 12.00..

This is the suggested Food pub. Greene King pub but has two guest ales.

A traditional London Tavern.

Apparently there is a camel on their garage roof (long story!) but I haven't seen it!

5. Mabels, 9 Mableton Place St Pancras WC1H 9AZ. Opens 12.00. Also does food. Shepherd Neame beers.

Bright unpretentious pub. The pub sponsors Soho F.C. Also does food.

6. The Exmouth Arms, 1 Starcross Street, NW1 2HR Opens 10.00 If you are still 'firsty' there this is the old BRB famous boozer round the back of what will be the site for the new HS2 platforms at Euston.
