Thomas Lloyd Spoons. Until 11:00

Out and left 20m down the Market Square to

Tilted Wig. 11:00-11:30. Similar to Spoons but less choice of beer. Food 3 hand pumps

Depending on selection available at one of these

Out and across square and down side to

Rose and Crown. 11:30-12:00. Three hand pumps Food or up the Hundreds to

Globe Three hand pumps Food

From either back to Spoons and round corner in 30m on opposite side of Old Square is

Old Coffee Tavern. 12:05- 12:45. Four hand pumps but only two in use on recce. Food

We are now on our way back to the station area for the remaining pubs. All well within 10 mins of station.

Out and left; at end by turn right at church turn down into Church Street walk to bottom turn left into Jury Street and keeping to the near pavement now walk down and across next major junction and nearly at end of next street is

Roebuck Inn 57, Smith St.13:00-13:30. Food 4 hand pumps.

Out and left and cross next road Priory Road and then across Coventry Road (going back to station) into Coten End on the left there is either

Oak no 27 ,2ales or Black Pug no 69 ,4ales

Either serves real ale but we will choose which one on the day depending what they have on.

To the last pub from the Oak turn left and left again into Guy Street. Or from the Black Pug back tp Guy Street. Walk to end under railway bridge and cross road and turn into Lakin Road 100m on left is

Wild Boar 6 hand pumps Slaughterhouse brewery behind pub.

Back to station Out and turn right and right again into Woodcote Road at end there is a climb up to London bound platform or under tunnel to BMS platform.

Travel from South.

Trains from Marylebone at :02 past the hour

From Leamington Spa:00:30:39

Travel from Birmingham. :15 and :45

Travel from Reading: 16 to Banbury and change.

Walk from station to Spoons.

From station to Spoons. Coming from Birmingham down and cross under railway onto other side. There is building work between the platform from Leamington and the station building,; just walk round the outside of the fencing then down Station Road and turn right into Coventry Street. At the end bear slightly left and at the next junction with turn right into Priory Road (a one way street with traffic coming down the hill) at the top cross the street which by the has changed its name to Northgate and at the next junction cross The Butts and the follow the pavement round into Northgate Street at the end turn right into Old Square and in 70m on the left is Market Square with Spoons on the left.

Or cross Priory Road and ahead into Smith Street continue up this street passing the Roebuck Inn on the right at the top cross The Butts and straight ahead into Jury Street. Turn right into Church Street and at the top by the Church ahead into Old Square and as above.

If you want a bus then the X17 from the bottom of Station Road and right for 30m on the hour and half hour. BEWARE it is counter intuitive the bus goes from the same side of the road as the station and makes a loop round outer Warwick back to the bus station on the other side of the hill.

The train times being fixed nicely miss the bus connections and leave you with a 20 minute wait.
