Wivenhoe was a port (closed 1992) and boat building (closed 1986) for centuries and was very important for carrying many types of goods by train to London especially fish and oysters. The Pubs

1. **Black Buoy**, Black Buoy Hill. 01206-822425 hrs 08-11 Best rural pub (Camra)

37th year running. 6 guest ales on constant rotation, Colchester's first community pub. Food 08:00-15:00. This pub now serves food prepared by a local cafe and hence is now open for breakfast.

2. **Rose& Crown**, The Quay, tel 01206-826371 hrs 11:00-23:00 This is now a Greene King pub but do 4 quest ales. 10% discount for Camra members.
